Minutes of the Beeford Parish Council Meeting

1. Apologies for Absence:

2. <u>Declaration of Interest</u> – Cllr Holmes expressed an interest in item 5b and abstained.

3. To accept minutes of the meeting held on 14th February 2022.

4. Matters arising.

a. The Chair opened the meeting announcing that Margaret Rose has been appointed as new clerk to the Parish Council and will be joining the Parish Council in due course. There will be an initial hand over period with the current Clerk during the month of April. As the new Clerk already has commitments to North Frodingham Parish Council on a Monday Evening, Beeford meeting dates will need to be changed and is currently under review.

The AGM will be scheduled for Monday 11th April when a new Chair and officers will be elected. Whilst discussing the Parish Council going forward the Chair took to the opportunity to mention Community Government Reviews which are currently being considered by the ERYC as to whether a parish could be altered either due to development or where Parish Councils are not able to carry out their duties and a review of boundaries could be considered. Cllr Evison said that this would not affect Beeford Parish but will confirm.

b. Cllr Sawyer announced that the Queen's Jubilee Committee has now been formed. Committee member Dave Young was also present at the meeting and confirmed that meetings are taking place and plans are currently being made and will be announced accordingly. Cllr Wilburn is constructing a Beacon which will be lit in line with other Beacons across the UK to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee – details to follow. A small grant namely Queen's Platinum Jubilee Community Fund is available from ERYC which can be applied for via the Parish Council towards the Village event. Cllr Sawyer will work alongside the current Clerk to apply for the funding.

5. <u>Correspondence</u>

a. An email has been received from Angela McKie, NOW Committee member, confirming that the NOW group will be disbanded after transfer of funds has been completed and the bank account closed. Committee member Dave Young confirmed that £9,598.53 will be given to the Beeford Playing Fields Association which will be divided between the Playing Fields Association £3,000, Beeford Community Centre £3,000, the Church £1,000 and the Chapel £1,000.

b. A letter has been received from Beeford Afternoon Tea and Social Club applying for funding from the Lissett Windfarm Trust towards the cost of an outing in July. The Chair read the letter out and it was duly agreed that the sum of £300 be awarded towards this event subject to the receipt of LWFF 2022/23 in the new financial year.
